## TELEHEALTH NETWORK UPDATE

### Scheduling web site

Most of you know there is a new Statewide Scheduling Website at:  
**<http://www.netelehealth.net>**.

Please register if you have not done so. There is a tutorial on the HHA website for this called [NSTN Scheduling web site registration tutorial](#).

Once you have registered, you need to assign a coordinator. Coordinators are able to schedule and/or request programs.

The website allows you to see program offerings throughout the state. All registered users can view the programs, but only coordinators can request participation which is why you need to have designated coordinators.

Programs are listed by date. Click on any date on the calendar to view the programs for that day. Detailed information about the program can be viewed by double clicking on the time of the program. The hosting bridge, or bridge that you will be connecting to for the program, is listed by initial next to the time of that program. Example: BLGH-BryanLGH, GSH-Good Samaritan in Kearney, FRHS – Norfolk, UNMC –Univ. Med Center, Omaha, etc. If there is no bridge listed, the contact person for that program will be listed in the details of the program and you can get connection information from that person.

The website is the reference for connection to all programs. By registering on the website and receiving your confirmation email, you do not have to make the extra call to schedule programs. If you have more than one Polycom or videoconferencing unit, please make sure to register the correct one that will be used for that program. If all of your equipment options are not listed on the website, please let us know so we can make sure they are listed properly.

**If you do not register for a program, you will not be able to connect because the connecting bridge will not have you included in the program.**

Overall, this system will save time and provide a much more accurate management of the requests for programming. If you have problems or questions, please contact Kandi Thomas or Carol Brandl and we will assist you.
